

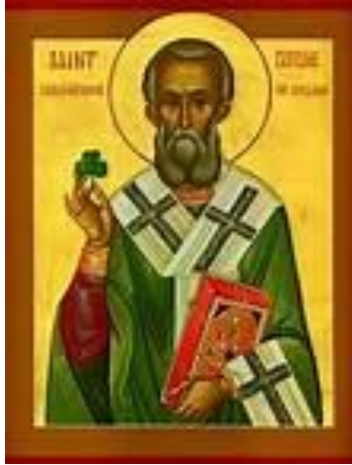

This category be added as a trial with prizes of \$25 for Best in Class and two \$15 Judges' Choice awards along with the usual show ribbons.
